CASS

Most popular beer in Korea

SOJU

Distilled beverage native to Korea, made from rice.

Its tastes is comparative to vodka, but slightly sweeter and lower alcohol %.

Very popular and matches with any Korean food.

360ml 20% alc. 17



CITRON/ PEACH SOJU

Best selling alcohol in Korea 2015

It adds fruity flavor to SOJU and even lower alcohol %.

BEK SE JU

Korean Traditional rice wine, is brewed with unique method and valuable 12 herbs. "Bek Su" mean 100years old. It doesn't refer to the age of the wine but the health benefit this wine offers.

CHUNG HA

Made purely from rice. Tastes similar to Japanese sake, but only easier to drink.

MAK GEOLLI

Made from a mixture of wheat and rice, which gives it a milky colour and sweetness.

SUL JOONG MAE (Plum wine)

Liquor made from steeping Korean plums (while still unripe and green) in Soju and sugar.

It has a sweet, sour taste, and alcohol content of 10 to 15%. The taste and aroma of this can appeal to those who normally don't drink alcohol much.

BOK BUN JA (Black raspberry wine)

Fruit wine made from Korean raspberry.
